City parking meters becoming computerized

Ken Fisher is one of three parking collection employees going through training to learn a new computerized inventory system for city parking meters. The new system inventories individual meters and helps schedule maintenance with a diagnostic program. The program will warn parking collection employees of potential problems, such as weak batteries and wear-and-tear to the meter. The city's Internet Technology department is building a database for each meter. Key West City Manager Julio Avel said it is one way for the city to become proactive with the meters, instead of being reactive to complaints.
